The Green Street General Meeting is fast approaching, and we would like to provide you with a few additional details in order to ensure that the event is a complete success. To this end, we have enclosed the agenda for the meeting, which is subject to change. In the meantime, enjoy your travels, and we look forward to seeing you back here in Montréal!

1. Sending materials

Unfortunately, it is not possible for us to receive display cases or presentation panels for the event. However, if you are able to travel with these items at no additional cost, we can place them in the meeting areas. In terms of promotional materials, for environmental reasons and in light of the limited storage facilities at the YWCA, we request that you send only the bare minimum to the Centrale des syndicats du Québec, to the attention of Gilles Campagna, 9405 rue Sherbrooke Est, Montréal, QC, H1L 6P3. In addition, please do not send more than the equivalent of 1/2 box of 8 1/2" X 11" paper (10 lbs). However, electronic materials can be placed in the Community Centre section of the website, and will be available to anyone who wishes to use them.

2. Shuttle

Aérobis^{MD}, which is operated by Groupe La Québécoise, provides an efficient coach shuttle service between Montréal-Trudeau Airport and downtown Montréal.

The Aérobis shuttle stops at the Station Centrale d'Autobus Montréal, which is located at 505 boul. de Maisonneuve Est. A minibus service will be available from the Station Centrale to certain downtown hotels at no additional charge (for reservations or information, please call 514-631-1856).

Duration of travel: Allow approximately 45 minutes.

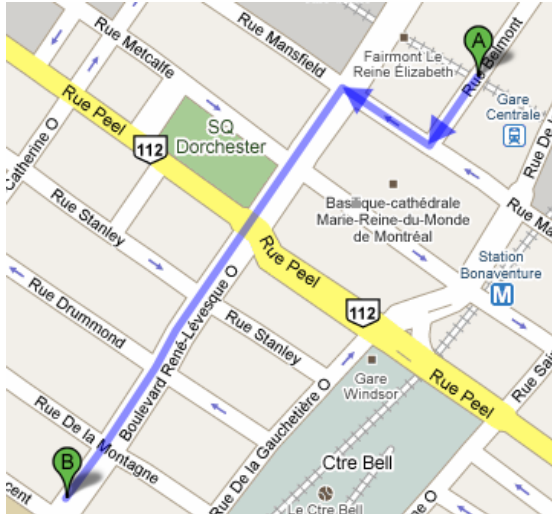

3. Directions from the Gare centrale de Montréal (for those travelling by train)

For those who would like to walk from the Gare centrale de Montréal (A) to l'Hôtel du Y de Montréal (B), here are a few directions:

Distance 0.7 km –walking time: approximately 9 minutes



1. Head southwest on rue Belmont toward rue Mansfield. Walk 92 m (approximately 1 minute).
2. Turn right on Rue Mansfield. Walk 0.1 km (approximately 1 minute).
3. Turn left onto Boulevard René-Lévesque O. Walk 0.5 km (approximately 7 minutes). The building will be on your right.

5. Transportation between the Science Centre and the Canadian Centre for Architecture



1. (A) By foot
Walk from **de la Commune / McGill** (approximately 2 minutes)
2. **Bus** - 515 - Vieux Montréal/ Vieux-Port - Direction: Metcalfe / Square Dorchester
Depart from **de la Commune / McGill**
3. Arrive at **Peel / de La Gauchetière**
4. **Métro** - 2 - Orange - Direction: Côte-Vertu Station
7 minutes for the connection
5. Depart from **Bonaventure Station**
6. Arrive at **Georges-Vanier Station**

7. By foot, walk **southwest** along **Rue Saint-Antoine O** toward **Rue Du Fort** (approximately 29 m)
8. Turn **right** onto **Rue Du Fort** (0.3 km)
9. Turn **right** onto **Rue Baile** (0.1 km)
The building is on your right.

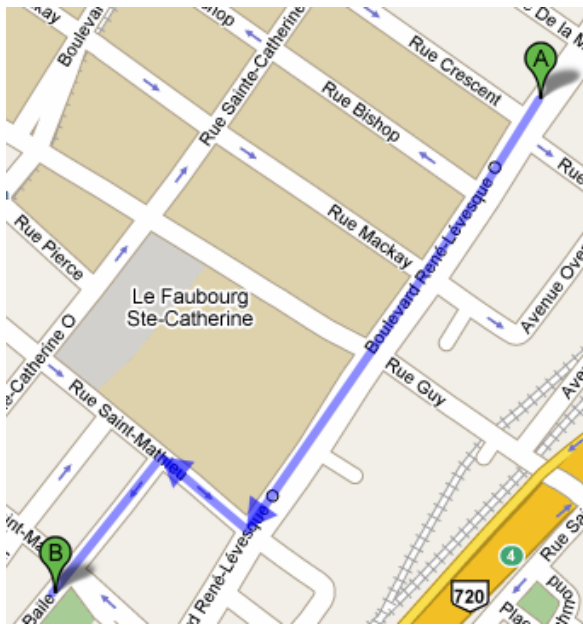
collect the largest amount of information possible before spending more time with the organizations of your choice. Bring your photos and your ideas. Interesting meetings await!

8. Evenings: May 13 and 14, 2009

You are all invited to the Canadian Centre for Architecture on May 13 at 7:30 p.m. The CCA is located at 1920 rue Baile, Montréal, QC, H3H 2S6. Our speaker will be Dr. Louise Chawla, Teacher and Environmental Psychologist, who will discuss the ties that youths have forged with their community and with nature so that we will be better equipped to interact with young people and the environment in which they live.

2. Turn right onto Rue Saint-Mathieu. Walk 0.1 km (approximately 1 minute).
3. Turn left onto Rue Baile. Walk 0.2 km (approximately 2 minutes).

May 15, 2009 walk schedule

- 9:00 a.m. Walkers gather at Parc Lafontaine. Be sure to arrive early in order to participate in the activities for walkers.
- 10:00 a.m. Departure for the Marche 2/3.
- 12:00 noon Procession arrives at Parc Lafontaine (end of event).

We will give you the directions for getting to the start location for the walk. Don't forget to bring sturdy shoes, because the walk is approximately 6 km. The metro station closest to the start location is Sherbrooke, which is a 5-minute walk from the gathering location. Volunteers will be stationed on rue Cherrier in order to indicate the route to take, and to make sure safety rules are respected.

10. Reimbursement of fees

In an effort to make your trip to Montréal and your participation in the General Meeting even more enjoyable, we have put together a list of fees that will be reimbursed to you after we receive the fee reimbursement form (to be handed out on-site) and supporting documents, if applicable:

- Shuttle: \$25 return (you must keep your receipt in order to be reimbursed)
- Travel expenses: \$0.40/km if travelling by car (with a pre-authorized and pre-determined maximum for individuals from outside of the province of Québec)
- Meals on May 15 during the trip home, based on the following scale:

Breakfast:	\$9.50
Lunch:	\$15.00
Supper:	\$25.00
